The Ivy League men's swimming championship was determined by round-robin standings until 1997, when the Eastern Intercollegiate Swimming League meet began determining the League champion. Since 2009, the Championship meet has included only Ivy League schools.

Year-by-Year Finishes

NOTE: There was no team scoring in the championship meet from its inception in 1938 until 1962. Until the mid-1990s, the Championship included up to 28 Eastern seaboard schools. Until the meet became a smaller, more focused event, the Ivy League Championship was not determined here, but by a round-robin record instead. In 2009, the meet switched to include just the eight Ivy League schools.
