Entry Rules

Individual Events

- Any eligible swimmer who has swum the qualifying time for an individual event <u>during the 2019-2020 season in a VISAA meet</u> may be entered in that event. <u>Proof of Time must be submitted</u> with entries.
- The following requirements must be met for a meet to count for state meet qualifying times:
 - It must be a multi-team meet in which a team represents their school.
 - Times swum in a single team time trial do not count for qualification.
 - The meet must have certified officials, including a starter/referee and a stroke and turn judge.
 - The time must be recorded with either a touch pad or at least two watches.
- Each team is allowed unlimited entries in individual events, but only a team's top four (4) qualifiers are eligible for the Championship or Consolation Finals.
 - In the event any team qualifies more than 4 swimmers in the top 16 during prelims, the coach must designate which 4 swimmers will swim in the evening session.
 - Designations must be turned in to the timing & scoring operator within 15-minutes of the conclusion of the preliminary session.
- An individual swimmer may swim no more than two (2) individual events and no more than four (4) total events, including relays.

 Coaches are responsible for ensuring swimmers entered in the meet satisfy all entry criteria stated above. In the event an athlete exceeds individual entry limits and is not caught during the entry process, the athlete must swim/dive the first four (4) events in which he or she is entered, in chronological order.

Bonus Event

- Any swimmer that has otherwise qualified for the meet in either an individual or a relay event is eligible to enter into the Bonus 50 Freestyle.
- Swimmers must meet the Bonus qualification time to enter the event.
- Entry in the event will count against a swimmer's event total.
- Bonus event swimmers are not eligible to score points in the event.

Relays

- Each team that has had a relay swim the qualifying time during the season may enter a single "A" relay in that relay event.
- Any swimmer who participates in a relay during the season that meets the State qualifying time is eligible to swim in that relay event at the State Meet.
- Any swimmer who has qualified for an individual event, including diving, is eligible to swim in any relay at States.
- Each team may also enter one exhibition "B" Relay in all three relay events, but every swimmer on that relay must have <u>qualified either individually</u> or <u>on a relay that met the qualifying</u> <u>time during the season.</u> "Exhibition" means that the "B" Relays may not score.
- Relays may be entered without swimmers' names, but the Meet Host would appreciate a projected relay line up with all entries.
- Swimmers who participate in a "B" Relay during the preliminary session may compete in an "A" Relay of the same event during finals. This will still count as 1 event for the swimmer.

Relay Cards

- 200 Medley Relay Cards specifying the actual relay line-up shall be submitted to the Meet Secretary thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the session.
- 200 Free Relay Cards specifying the actual relay line-up shall be submitted to the Meet Secretary prior to the conclusion of the Women's 500 Freestyle.

	 400 Free Relay Cards specifying the actual relay line-up shall be submitted to the Meet Secretary prior to the conclusion of the Women's 100 Breaststroke. Swimmers whose names are submitted on the relay cards must swim that event, in the order listed on the card, unless the Meet Referee allows for a substitution because of injury or illness. Any team that chooses not to submit a relay card or does not submit a relay card by its respective deadline must swim the relay in the order listed in the meet program. *If enforcement of this regulation causes a swimmer's total event count to exceed four (4) total events, the swimmer/relay is subject to the following NFHS regulation: The competitor(s) is/are disqualified from that event and further competition. The competitor(s) shall not be disqualified from events in subsequent rounds for which he/she has previously, legally qualified. *If a relay was entered into the meet without athlete names, the 		
	relay will be disqualified.		
Scratch	Scratches will not be accepted for Preliminary events.		
Procedures for	 Swimmers may declare a false start by reporting to the head official 		
Preliminaries	prior to his or her event.		
Tremmunes	A declared false start will count towards the event total of a swimmer		
	but will not cause any further penalties, such as removal from the meet.		
	 Any swimmer who misses his or her event during Preliminaries will be



 VISAA Championship meet file do NOT create your own file.
 - The meet file may be downloaded from the SwimCloud meet page at https://www.swimcloud.com/results/145873/.
- All entries, including divers, must be submitted with a Hy-Tek Team Manager entry file. **No manual or hardcopy entries will be accepted.**
 - When submitting entries, please include both a Hy-Tek meet entry file as well as a Hy-Tek team roster file.
- Entries must include first and last name, gender, grade level (8th to 12th grade) and seed times.
 Seed times should be actual or converted short-course yard times that meet the qualifying standards.
- Entries submitted without grade level will be rejected. Please confirm the grade levels for your swimmers prior to entry so the program reflects correct information.
- Coaches must submit entries with a "Proof of Time":

*Email to Ginger should include a Meet Entry file, a Team Roster file, and a Meet Entry Report including Proof of Times in PDF format.

- Except for relays, all entries are final once they are submitted.
- Once submitted, the person who e-mailed the entries will receive a confirmation e-mail with an attached list of that team's official entries by 9pm, Monday, February 10th. It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entries to verify that the entries were received and that they were received accurately. 





Starting Procedures for Preliminaries and Finals

- The Referee and Starter will use the standard USA Swimming whistle start.
- The procedure will be as follows:
 - 4 or 5 consecutive whistles means get ready.
 - o The Announcer will announce the event.
 - 1 long whistle means to step up on the block (into pool for backstroke).
 - For backstroke only, there will be another long whistle in lieu of a command to place your feet.
 - The starter will simply say "Take Your Mark," and a horn will signal the start.
- We will use dive over starts for Prelims, but not for Finals.
- For each Final Event, we will:
 - o Swim the Consolation Finals (Preliminary qualifier 9 thru 16).
 - Parade the top 8 qualifiers to the blocks with music selected by the top qualifier.
 - Swim the Championship Finals.
 - After both the girls and boys have completed a particular event, we will present medals to the top 8 girl and boy finishers from the two previous events.

Meet Dispute Procedure


- Any coach may file a protest with the Head Referee for matters not specifically covered by the rules or a misapplication of the rules.
 - Judgment calls are not subject to protest.
 - Concerns over Stroke and Turn disqualifications may be referred to the Head Referee but cannot be protested unless the concern is a misapplication of the rules.
- If such an event occurs, a seven (7) member "Meet Committee" will have the authority to settle such disputes.
 - The Meet Committee shall consist of the VISAA President, the VISAA Meet Director (for swimming and administrative issues) or Diving Coordinator (for diving issues), the four VISAA Regional Representatives and the VISAA Secretary.
- The Meet Committee will have the original disqualification explained to them with all involved parties present, after which anyone else that wishes to speak will have their opportunity.
- Once the committee convenes on its own and reaches a final decision, it will be the responsibility of the VISAA President to communicate that decision to the individual having filed the protest and it will be the responsibility of the Secretary to document both the protest filed and the outcome decided, so as to have a reference for future occurrences.

Spirit

- Teams are strongly encouraged to bring banners to display (see next section).
- Teams are highly encouraged to do cheers prior to the start of the meet and during breaks, though it should remain quiet for any race start.
- No face or body paint of any type is allowed.
- Feathered or similar boas are not permitted on the pool deck.
- Marker or temporary tattoos are allowed as long as they are respectful, sportsmanlike, and do not wash off in the water.
- It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure athletes adhere to these guidelines. Any damages to a facility that result from failure to adhere to these guidelines will be the fiscal responsibility of the offending team/school.

Team Banners

- All team banners should be turned in to the meet clerk upon arrival at the facility, so that they may be hung in accordance with the facility regulations.
- Please be sure to pick up your banner at the conclusion of the meet.

Senior Parade

Prior to the Saturday night Finals, we will run a Senior Parade to recognize all of the seniors. The Parade is a time of celebration, and seniors are encouraged to dress for the occasion. To ensure the appropriateness of the dress and behavior for the event, the following guidelines will be enforced:

- Athletes are strongly encouraged to wear their school warm-ups or other school-related attire.
- No swimsuits may be worn without shorts, a warm-up suit, or other school-related attire covering them.
- Athletes may appropriately add fun hats, beads, capes, wings, etc. to their attire.
- No face or body paint of any type.
- Absolutely no outfits with a sexual innuendo, such as, but not limited to: Playboy bunnies, beauty queens, boys or girls dressed in drag, undergarments worn over the top of warm-ups, body parts drawn onto the body, high heels, etc.
- A committee made up of the Meet Director(s), the VISAA Swimming President, and the Senior Parade Coordinator will walk down the line of seniors prior to the parade in order to give seniors who are not in compliance ample opportunity to get into compliance.
- Swimmers that do not comply with the guidelines will be asked to remove the offensive material. If they choose not to remove, they will not walk in the Senior Parade. Please do not put the Parade Coordinator in the uncomfortable position of excluding a senior from the Parade.



Pool Rules

- Concessions will be allowed in designated areas only. Drinks are permitted in plastic bottles or covered cups.
- Young children must be supervised by an adult.
- Observers and spectators are to stay in designated areas.
- No tape of any kind is to be used inside to hang signs, banners, or decorations.
- Only Aquatic Center staff is permitted in the Aquatics Offices,
 Equipment Room, and First Aid Office unless approved by Aquatic Center staff or management.
- No smoking or vaping is permitted within the center facilities.
- The Aquatic Center is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Make sure someone you know is always present supervising individual/team belongings.
- No unauthorized persons are permitted to use the stereo system without the permission of the Aquatic Center Director.
- No glass containers of any kind are to be brought into the pool complex.
- Parking violators will be subject to fines and/or towing as posted.
 - No parking in the skatepark parking lot
 - No parking in the areas marked by the yellow curb
 - Overflow parking will be prearranged with Christiansburg High School on weekends
- The Aquatic Center strongly encourages showering prior to entering the pool.
- All emergency exits and walkways must remain clear throughout the meet.
- In compliance with USA Swimming Safe Sport, the back building entrance, under the diving tower is a secure entrance reserved for facility staff and essential personnel with access cards or swim meet credentials.



Inclement Weather Contingency Plans

- In the event of inclement weather, the executive committee, comprised of the VISAA Swimming & Diving Committee President, Secretary, and Meet Coordinator, will work alongside the Executive Director of the VISAA to enact one of the following contingency plans, which will be communicated to meet participants as quickly and effectively as possible. Points of contact for each team are encouraged to check VISAA.org in the event of inclement weather, where the most up-to-date information can be found regarding the championship meet.
- Contingency Plan A:
 - The format of the meet will remain the same but will shift back by 1-day. The Thursday evening warm-up session would be moved back to Friday evening and the Friday/Saturday events would be switched to Saturday/Sunday, respectively.
 - Diving events will take place between preliminary and final sessions and Friday/Saturday sessions would be moved back to Saturday/Sunday, respectively.
- Contingency Plan B:
 - The format of the meet will be condensed, combining all preliminary heats into 1 session, both male and female diving into 1 session, and all final heats into 1 session. Warm-ups will be scheduled to take place on Friday morning/afternoon and session 1 (all preliminary heats) will be swum Friday afternoon/evening. Diving for both sexes will take place Saturday morning (session 2). All final rounds will be swum in session 3 on Saturday evening.



Directions

- From I-81 Southbound
 - Take the US-11/US-460 exit, Exit 118C-B-A, toward Christiansburg/Blacksburg (1.6 miles)
 - Merge onto US-460 W via Exit 118B toward Blacksburg (2.7 miles)
 - Take the US 460 Business exit, Exit 3AB, toward Christiansburg (0.4 miles)
 - Merge onto US-460 BR E/N Franklin St. via Exit 3A toward US-460-BR E/VA-111/Downtown (0.8 miles)
 - Stay in the right lane and proceed through the next 2 stoplights.

Bus and Overflow Parking
