**Entry Procedure:** **TM Entry File Due Date: Monday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 5:00pm**  
**Delimited Dive Entries Due: Tuesday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 5:00pm**

- **Swimming Entries:** All entries are due **Monday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, @ 5pm**. E-mail your team manager entry file to [dannymandziuk@gmail.com](mailto:dannymandziuk@gmail.com).
  - Danny will be collecting all entries, sending confirmation, and then will send out the psych sheet. Then he will send the Meet Manager Backup to Doug.
  - You are allowed 40 Varsity/Scoring individual entries, including divers. Any entries over the 40 maximum individual entries (including diving) must be marked exhibition and entered into the exhibition event that is prior to the Varsity event. **Divers must be included in a team's entry file.**
  - Each school is allowed unlimited Exhibition/JV entries. These must be in the JV events listed prior to the Varsity events in the Team Manager file.
  - "C" Relays and lower are considered to be Exhibition these should be marked Exhibition in the TM file.
  - You will be allowed to enter as many relays as you wish for prelims. Only "A" relays and "B" relays, not disqualified in prelims, will move onto Finals on Saturday. You may opt out of the "B" relay, please let the timing office know by the end of the swimming prelims on Friday, otherwise they will be seeded for Saturday. Only "A" relays will score.
  - **Entries MUST be in Hy-tek Team Manager. NO EXCEPTIONS** (Team Manager Lite is available for download to do your entries at [www.hy-tektd.com](http://www.hy-tektd.com))
- **Diving Entries:** Delimited entries due Tuesday February 20<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm to [douglas.irey@gmail.com](mailto:douglas.irey@gmail.com). We will be using e-Dive, so it is important to use the delimited format. To find information on the delimited format, look at pages 115 and 116 of the following website: <http://www.edive.info/downloads/edivehelp.pdf>. You can also address the final page of this packet for diving entries. Please make sure you are sending a legal 11-dive list with voluntary dives declared per the instructions. Changes can be made up to 30 minutes before the start of prelims.
- **Entry Confirmation:** Will be e-mailed to the coaches by Tuesday February 20<sup>th</sup> @ 10:00am. Any changes must be e-mailed to Danny Mandziuk by Tuesday @ 9:00pm.
- **Psych Sheets** will be emailed to the coaches on Wednesday February 21<sup>st</sup>. No changes will be allowed after the psych sheets have been published. After they have been emailed Danny will turn the backup file over to Doug.
- **Scratches:** Please inform Doug by e-mail if you are scratching anyone so that an accurate heat sheet can be produced. Please send by Friday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 8:00am.

- At finals, two heats of relays will swim (A and B), 3 heats of individual events. Each individual event's first heat will consist of the 17<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> fastest performances from prelims (comprised of both Exhibition/JV and Scoring/Varsity entries); the Top-16 qualifiers will swim in heats 2 and 3 respectively and will be comprised of only Scoring/Varsity Entries.

### Scoring:

#### Top-16 Championship Scoring.

- Only "A" Relays will score per the LVC bylaws. Relay points are double. Finals heats will be locked in (A-B-C format).
- Divers *must* complete eleven dives (championship format) for final placing in the Conference meet. Top-16 will move onto finals. The first 8 rounds will be completed on Friday. The Top-16 after 8 rounds will compete on Saturday. JV divers will complete their final 3 dives on Friday night.

### Meet Schedule:

Friday: Swimming- 10:00am Warm-Up, 12:00pm Start.

Diving- Warm-Up at least 1.5 hours after the conclusion of swim prelims (approx. 3:00), more will be available as necessary.

Prelims will start after no earlier than after 1.5 hours of warm-up.

Saturday: 8:00am-10:00am- Diving Warm-Up

10:00am-11:45am- Swimming Warm-Up

12:00pm- Meet Start

*The small pool will remain open the entire meet for warm-up and cool down.*

### Meet Format:

- All events are timed finals, 8 lanes will be swam in competition.
- The maximum number of events that a swimmer can enter is 3 relays and 1 individual or 2 relays and 2 individual events.
- No food on the pool deck area
- All swimmers must wear shoes in the outer hallways
- No swimmers are allowed in the stands. This is to protect our spectators from injury due to a wet surface.
- The meet will be governed by National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules. Officials will dual confirm relay exchanges and starts.

- Admission/Seating:** Admission is \$5. Programs \$3. All spectators will remain in the gallery. Only coaches, competitors, team managers and meet personnel will be allowed on the deck. Due to limited deck space, we are asking that only the athletes that are swimming and alternates, coaches and managers on the pool deck. All others need to sit in the spectator's area.

## *Diving Entries Instructions*

*Please follow instructions carefully and make sure your divers' lists are accurate and legal.* \*Please make sure all 5 groups are covered in the first 8 dives. And remember that your required dive list cannot exceed 9.0.\*

The meet will be entered and scored using eDive. All diving entry details will be submitted in .txt file format by email to [douglas.irey@gmail.com](mailto:douglas.irey@gmail.com) by Tuesday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 5pm.

**Please use the following instructions to modify the sample diving entries .txt file that is also provided:**

You can use Notepad or any text editor to edit the attached sample dive entry file for your school's entries.

***Please make sure the file is saved as normal text (.txt) and not rich-text (.rtf).*** In order to differentiate between all of the files received, please name the file using your team name. So, if your team is from Johnson High School then name your text file "JohnsonHighSchoolEntries.txt".

- \* **There should be no empty lines at the beginning of the file.**
- \* **Each diver should only be listed once in the file.**
- \* **Each line will be a complete entry record for that diver.** All of one diver's information must be listed on the same line in the following format separated by commas as follows:  
"divername", "teamname", dive1, dive2, dive3, dive4, dive5, dive6, dive7, dive8, dive9, dive10, dive11
- \* **The divers name must be enclosed in double quote marks.** The quotes are not two single quotes ( ' ' ) at the beginning and at the end but rather one double quote ( " ) at the beginning and another double quote at the end.
- \* **The team name must be enclosed in double quote marks.** The quotes are not two single quotes ( ' ' ) at the beginning and at the end but rather one double quote ( " ) at the beginning and another double quote at the end.
- \* **The dive numbers for each round are listed in round order and separated by a single comma.** Dive positions are listed directly after each dive number. So, a 403 pike would be listed as 403B.
- \* **If the dive is a voluntary/required dive then the dive position must be followed by the letter V.** So, a 401 pike voluntary would be listed as 401BV.
- \* **Do not include spaces around the commas separating the information.**
- \* **Capitalization does not matter in the diver's name, team name or dive positions.** But please note that the divers name and team name will be added to the meet database exactly as typed.
- \* **The order that the divers are listed in the text file doesn't matter.**

The sample entry text file has the following format. This high school is Johnson High School which has 3 divers each doing 11 dives.

"John Dover", "Johnson High School", 101AV, 201AV, 303C, 103B, 403C, 401BV, 5111AV, 203B, 301AV, 104C, 202B  
"Peter Grange", "Johnson High School", 401CV, 402C, 101CV, 103C, 302C, 301CV, 201CV, 5121D, 5111BV, 102B, 202C  
"John Stubach", "Johnson High School", 401BV, 403B, 103BV, 203B, 303B, 5132DV, 201BV, 5124D, 301BV, 105B, 5223D
